

BROWNIE TRY-IT PROGRAMS

Fee- \$3.00 per girl per hour. One adult per 10 girls will be admitted free of charge. Additional adults pay \$3.00 each per hour. Each activity will accommodate up to 12 girls. If your troop numbers more than 12, choose two activities for a two-hour visit and divide the girls into two groups.

Schedule- These are one-hour activities suitable for after school on a weekday or any time on a weekend day. One or two activities may be scheduled per visit.

Stitch It Together

Embroidery

Learn some embroidery stitches and start a sampler of different stitches.

Sew What?

Make a beanbag (or sachet bag).

Patch It All Together

Design your own quilt square using wallpaper and poster board. Use this as a pattern to start your cloth square. (Girls need to provide their own fabric).

Weaving Color Patterns

Try your hand at weaving with a floor loom. Then learn either the “tabby” or “twill” weave and create your own color pattern with paper strips.
